As the ranks of the survivors dwindle, we realize that this is likely to be the last generation of children who will have this special honor. We invite 2nd & 3rd generations to join us.

The program will be appropriate for children in fourth grade and older, but given the sensitive nature of the subject, all children should be accompanied by at least one adult.
